Conceição Evaristo

The Brazilian writer Maria da Conceição Evaristo de Brito was born in a favela in Belo Horizonte in 1946. She was a part of a very poor family with her mother and nine brothers. She worked as a domestic servant until 1971, when she finished school. Conceição Evaristo is a huge exponent of contemporary Brazilian literature. She writes about important topics, such as race and gender and class discrimination, especially of black women.

Rupi Kaur

Rupi Kaur is an accomplished poet, artist, and performer known for her incredible talent.

During her time as a 21-year-old college student, Rupri crafted, illustrated, and independently published her very first collection of poetry called milk and honey. Following its success, she also unveiled its artistic companion, the sun and her flowers. These remarkable works have sold 10 million copies worldwide and have been translated into 42 languages. Recently, Rupri's latest book, home body, reached the top of bestsellers lists globally, securing the #1 spot. Additionally, in 2021, Rupri took on the role of

executive producer and lead performer in her inaugural film project, Rupri Kaur Live, which is currently available for streaming on Amazon Prime Video.

Rupri's creative expressions delve into profound themes such as love, loss, trauma, healing, femininity, and migration. She finds a true sense of belonging when immersed in the process of artistic creation or when captivating audiences with her powerful poetry performances on stage.
